Outreach & Ministry Prayer Update



Missionaries in Ukraine

In their most recent communication, one of our missionary couples in Ukraine shared, "Praise the Lord we had no problems at the border and that our car and apartment are in good shape. We needed to renew our temporary residency permits at the immigration office; thankfully the Lord helped us remember how to get there since our GPSs weren't working and the city renamed all the streets! When we arrived, we heard loud rumbling, an explosion, and the sound of a drone flying nearby. The Ukrainian visa representative we were meeting was waiting for us outside in the parking lot and a drone flew right over his head. We headed into the underground parking lot beneath the building and waited for the all-clear. After we submitted part of our documents, the alarms sounded again, so we had to exit the building (workers included). Because the Russians target public places, if you are in any kind of store or office when the sirens go off, you have to leave the building, go outside, find shelter, and wait for the all-clear. Our Ukrainian visa rep. told us that when there are incoming drones and missiles, the Ukrainian military sends out jamming signals so the enemy will not be able to hone in on their targets. This is apparently what prevents our GPSs from working. After the all-clear, we were allowed back inside to finish our documents. Then, we sort of "felt our way" back home. Praise God He gave us calmer hearts than usual before arriving in Ukraine. The Lord has really been coming through for us."
